# Daily Schedule

The program includes qualified chaperones certified in first aid and CPR; transportation; admission fees; daily lunches; 3 dinners at Disney; four t-shirts; and insurance. # Activity Descriptions

The preliminary program activities have been carefully selected with the goal of providing a wide range of age-appropriate, educational, social and cultural experiences unique to Orlando, FL. Kama`aina Kids will work with NMA convention planners to develop a program which is convenient for parents and conventioners, as well as, enjoyable and memorable for participants. The following activity descriptions detail the Camp NMA-Zing Youth 2018 Program. Activities are subject to change due to availability in August 2018.

1. Disney's **Magic Kingdom** is the flagship park of Walt Disney World, based on the original Disneyland in California. Magic Kingdom captures the enchantment of fairy tales with exciting entertainment and rides, classic attractions, beloved Disney characters and much more. With the iconic Cinderella's Castle as its centerpiece, the enormous 107-acre park is split into six lands based on different themes – Main Street, U.S.A., Adventureland, Frontierland, Fantasyland, Tomorrowland and Liberty Square.
2. Disney's **Animal Kingdom** is filled with attractions, adventures and entertainment that reflect Walt Disney's dedication to nature and conservation. The park is home to more than 1,700 animals from 250 species, and leads the way in animal care, education and research. Sprawling across 500 acres of lush landscape, Animal Kingdom is the biggest animal-themed park in the world. Exciting attractions await, along with live and wild entertainment like Broadway-style musical shows and parades that invite you to be part of the excitement. From the spectacular scenery of the African savanna to the high-altitude, roller coaster thrills of Expedition Everest in Asia, global adventures abound at Disney's Animal Kingdom.
3. Groups 2 and 3 will attend **"Principles of Animal Behavior"**, a Disney Youth Education Series (Y.E.S.) Program which explores the fascinating and surprising world of animal behavior. Participants can see exotic animals in their natural habitat and engage in hands-on activities to learn how they survive and thrive. Through observation and exploration of wildlife, students will discover how behavior contributes to animals' well-being and survival in the wild. Traveling through the unique lands of Disney's Animal Kingdom park, students will gain knowledge of the challenges and threats that face wildlife populations, along with the potential consequences and impact these adversities have on humankind. This journey leads students to understand that each animal species has a place in the circle of life.
4. Group 4 – 6 will attend **"Energy and Waves"**, a 3-hour Disney Y.E.S. Program. Together we will embark on an interactive adventure where we can explore the physics of light and sound through select attractions at Magic Kingdom park and examine the wide range of the electromagnetic spectrum. Students will discover how energy is transmitted by light and sound waves. Participants will also learn how these waves affect the Disney Guest experience and day-to-day life. Additionally, students find out how light and sound can be manipulated.
5. Let's get ready for down-home family fun at "The Alligator Capital of the World" – **Gatorland!** We'll see alligators and crocodiles of all sizes, from babies, also known as grunts, to the 14-foot monsters that call the Breeding Marsh home. Gatorland boasts the largest collection of extremely rare white leucistic alligators. Additionally a free-flight aviary, petting zoo and one-of-a-kind animal shows ensure that our day will be full of fun, smiles and special memories!

6. The **Camp NMA-Zing Talent Show** gives our young stars a chance to shine. Groups will practice a song, dance, skit or other talent to perform for our live audience of their peers and our staff judges!
7. The **Camp NMA-Zing Pre-teen and Teen Dance**, for ages 12 and up, is an onsite dance party for youth to unwind, express imagination and artistry, and celebrate with their friends. A live DJ, lighting effects, dance contests and more will make this last evening of camp one to remember.
